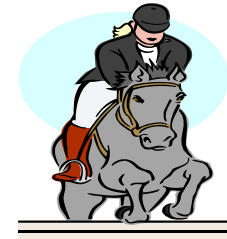

I request permission to participate in a Hunter Pace with the Woodbury FFA.

I fully understand that Hunter pacing (which includes riding over fences, other obstacles, and steep and rough terrain) is a very dangerous activity. I wish to participate in this activity knowing it is dangerous. I accept and assume all the risks of injury (including death) to me and/or to my property.

### Entry Information

Pre- Entry Fees are \$55 for senior riders and \$45 for Junior riders 18 & under as of 1/1/11

Pre-Entries MUST be postmarked and/ or received by 10/19/11

Post- Entry Fees are \$65 for Seniors and \$55 for Juniors

Copy of Rabies Certificate and copy of Negative Coggins Test within 1 year of pace date MUST accompany entry. HORSES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON GROUNDS IF PROPER PROOF IS NOT SUBMITTED PER MARCH FARMS.

### Divisions

Hack: for riders who prefer a modest, pleasure-type Pace

Hunt: for riders who prefer a more forward, traditional hunting pace

Each division will be further split into Junior and Senior Divisions. A Junior Team has both riders 18 and under as of 1/1/11, a mixed team will be considered a Senior team.

Awards given to highest placing FFA, 4-H, and Pony Club Teams. (Both junior riders must be members of the same club or chapter)

*The use of ASTM-SEI approved helmets are MANDATORY FOR ALL RIDERS*

Breakfast will be available for purchase. Lunch will be served free of charge for all riders (\$5 for non-riders) ONLY between the hours of 11 am and 2 pm. Lunch is non-refundable. Riders with times after 12:30 pm are encouraged to eat prior to their ride.

No refunds will be issued due to inclement weather or rider cancellation.

Submit paid pre-entry form to request start times, which are available between 8 am and 2 pm, with 3 minutes between riders, on a first-come, first-serve basis.
